

Coniston & Thirtleby Parish Council

Minutes of the meeting held on 6th September 2016 at the Coniston Village Hall.

Attendance: Cllrs. E. Stead, K. Stead, B. Higinbotham & C. Young.

1. **Public Participation.** Seven members of the public in attendance. Issues raised related to the proposals for a residential development on the current village hall site. The Council agreed to take on board the issues raised but confirmed that a formal planning application was yet to be submitted to the east Riding Council.
2. **Apologies.** Cllr. Hobson.
3. **Declarations of interest.** There were no declarations submitted.
4. **Police Issues.** Crime report for August 2016 indicated that a vehicle had been stolen from the Main Street layby on 22nd August. Noted.
5. **Approve minutes.** Minutes of the meeting held on 5th July 2016 were approved as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
6. **Clerk Report.** Nothing to report.
7. **Correspondence.** A letter was received from Graham Stuart MP regarding defibrillators. Clerk to advise Mr. Stuart that a defibrillator was sited at the Blacksmiths Arms.
8. **Planning Application.**
16/02403/VAR. Variation on condition 8, highway improvements. No objection.
9. **Accounts.** No accounts for approval. Still awaiting external audit report.
10. **Village Hall/Housing development proposals.** The Clerk reported that the agent for the proposed development was currently carrying out a feasibility study of the site and would keep the Council informed. There carried on a discussion regarding resident's concerns. The Chairman raised the issue of building boundaries and would find out if the proposals were within existing boundaries.
